1. To form 3-6 in schools, during school visits. Two hours long career guidance sessions which involve drama, PowerPoint Presentation, Ice breakers, question and answer, one on one sessions.
2. To teachers in schools: training teachers on how to give career guidance to learners on a regular basis
3. In community centers to School leavers
4. Online: through our what's app, Facebook and Instagram platforms. Our mentors are always ready to talk to Youths

Youth Mentorship	<p>1. What's app platform. Youths from the ages of 13-35 are mentored for a period of one year through what's app, phone calls and sometimes physical meetings.</p>
Free Mentorship training	<p>1. On what's app, any interested volunteer who wish to give back to the community through mentorship is trained by us to become an excellent mentor. The training takes 4 weeks. It focuses on the listening skills, building trust with mentees, setting goals, encouraging mentees, and giving feedback. All trained mentors receive e-certificates at the end of the training period. Trained mentors are then matched with a maximum of four mentees for a year.</p>
Entrepreneurship training.	<p>In schools, community centers, and online through what's app and zoom.</p>
Leadership training	<p>In schools, community centers, and online through what's app and zoom.</p>
Civic participation training	<p>In schools, community centers, and online through what's app and zoom. Training youths on Youth policies, how to participate and make a difference in their communities. How to give back.</p>
